1. Introduction

The Compact_Flash (CF_P_01A) contains Windows XP with English and Spanish already installed where English is the default language.

It also has the following languages already installed:

Chinese, Czech, Dutch, French, German, Italian, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Turkish.

2. Installing a Windows language.

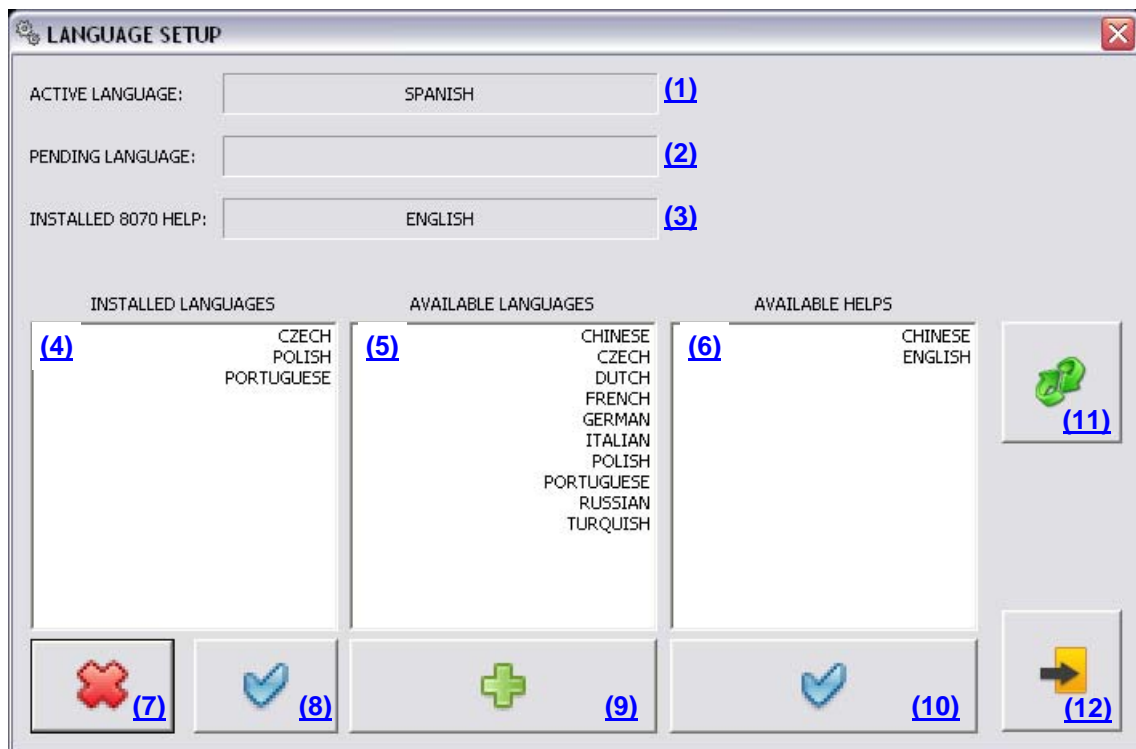
A DVD is supplied with the languages mentioned earlier for adding or removing a Windows language.

The application LangSetup.exe is also provided for removing or installing a new language. This application can also be used to install the help for the 8070 CNC in a particular language

Executing the application LangSetup.exe offers the following choices:

- Remove a Windows language already installed.
- Install a new one.
- Install the CNC help in a new language.

3. LangSetup.exe application



- (1) Active language being used by Windows in the current session.
- (2) Language set as active for the next Windows session. If this field is empty, it means that it is the same language as the one currently in use.
- (3) Help language already installed with the CNC8070.
- (4) List of languages already installed. Besides Spanish and English
- (5) List of languages available for installation. Each one corresponds to a compressed file (.zip) located in the same folder as the application.
- (6) List of CNC8070 helps available for installation. Each one corresponds to a compressed file (.zip) located in the same folder as the application.
- (7) Uninstall languages: Uninstalls the languages selected on the list (4), except when it is
 - a. the language currently in use (1),
 - b. the language of the next session (2),
 - c. the English language,
 - d. the Spanish language.
- (8) It activates the language selected on the list (4) as the language for the next Windows session (2).
- (9) Install language: Installs the languages selected on the list (5), except those already installed. A new language takes up about 100 Mbytes of disk memory.
- (10) Install Help: Installs the help selected for the CNC8070. It must be borne in mind that the current help will be uninstalled (only one help may be installed).
- (11) Refresh: It refreshes (updates) the data on the screen.
- (12) Exit: Closes the application.

The application and the necessary language files to install the languages/helps are located in the same folder as this document.

4. Example of how to install the French language

Example of how to install the French language in Windows and the 8070 help in French:

1. Copy from the DVD to a CNC folder or to a pendrive (USB flash) the *.dll, *.exe and the .zip files of the language or languages to be installed.
2. Verify that the application LangSetup.exe, the libraries LiteUnzip.dll and Litezip.dll, and the compressed files (.zip) of the languages to be installed are located in the same folder (FRENCH_0x040c.zip for Windows in French and HELP_FRENCH.zip for the cnc8070 in French).
3. Install the languages/helps by executing LangSetup.exe (selecting French on the list 5 and pressing the 9 button, selecting the help on list 6 and pressing the 10 button)
4. Exit the application and reboot if necessary.
